# WHAT ARE PREPOSITION

Prepositions are words which link nouns , pronouns and phrases to other words in a sentence.

Prepositions usually describe the position of something , the time when something happens and the way in which something is done, although the preposition “of ”, “to”, and “for” have some separate functions.

# COMPOUND PREPOSITION

Compound Prepositions are generally formed by prefixing a Preposition to a Noun , an Adjective or an Adverb.

# PHRASE PREPOSITION

The noun phrase which follows the preposition can be called a prepositional complement and the preposition together with its complement is known as a prepositional phrase.
